CONDUCT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

1. Certify that the above named player is in good health and that there is no physical or emotional reason prohibiting his/her participation in this program. Further, it is understood that a physical exam by a physician, prior to commencement of practice, will be required by all players who wish to participate in the WSLC program;
2. Agree that as the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s), I (we) will instruct the minor participant that prior to participating he/she should inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if the participant believes anything is unsafe, he/she should immediately advise his/her coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate, until such condition(s) are corrected;

Agree that as the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s), I (we) do fully understand my (our) responsibility to properly equip the above named player with protective equipment allowed by NCAA Rules to play the game, and accept full responsibility for assuring that the player wear a complete protective set of equipment when participating in any WSLC activity;
4. Understand that WSLC is a non-profit organization operated by volunteers for the benefit of young people. Agree to treat all volunteers and officials of the Lacrosse program, including coaches and referees, with appropriate courtesy and respect. Realize that any violations of proper conduct may result in the above-named player being dismissed from the lacrosse program without refund of fees. Further understand that all volunteers (including coaches) are volunteers, not professionals, and can only provide their best judgment and knowledge in instructing, guiding and making decisions for the above named player;
5. Understand that the success of the WSLC program is based entirely upon the donated work of volunteers and will try to volunteer my (our) services in order to provide an enjoyable, educational, healthful and athletic experience for all participants;

As the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s), I (we) do fully understand and agree that I (we) and the player will abide by the rules set for varsity athletics at West Salem High School recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with lacrosse and in consideration for the Salem Keizer School District and the WSLC accepting the player for its lacrosse program, I (we) hereby release, discharge, hold harmless and/or indemnify the Salem Keizer School District and the WSLC, its officers, directors, coaches, volunteers and parents, including owners of the fields and facilities utilized for the sport, against any claim by or on behalf of the player as a result of the player's participation in lacrosse and/or being transported to or for the same, which transportation I hereby authorize.

TRANSPORTATION AND RELEASE FORM

_____ (Name of player) may be involved in various athletic activities sponsored by WSLC. WSLC has elected to establish guidelines relating to transportation of player players for these events. There will be many activities that the WSLC will not be providing transportation to/from the event. For those events/activities, your player will be responsible for their own transportation. This form is intended to advise parents/guardians of these circumstances and to have the parents/guardians release WSLC from all liabilities arising out of players transporting themselves in privately owned vehicles.

I acknowledge that I have reviewed the following procedures:

- a) There may be times/occurrences in which my player will be transported in a privately owned vehicle.
- b) There may be times/occurrences in which my player will be transported in a vehicle driven by another adult, player or student.
- c) If a family or the player's personal vehicle is used in transporting players, I affirm that my player or I have statutory liability insurance, including uninsured and underinsured motorist's coverage.
- d) I stipulate, if I am involved in driving my own vehicle or my player/guardian is involved in driving a personally owned vehicle that the driver will adhere to all traffic ordinances and laws, including possessing a valid driver's license at all times.
- e) I further agree to release from liability and to indemnify and hold harmless the WSLC, coaches, officers, sponsors, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all claims and liabilities (including costs and attorney fees) arising out of or in any way connected to the transportation of my player in personally owned vehicles either owned by me or any other party. This Release and Indemnity Agreement includes claims based upon negligence.
- f) I understand that I am responsible for damage to any family/personal vehicles.
- g) I further affirm that I have carefully read and understand this agreement and all of its terms. I understand that it is an AGREEMENT TO RELEASE AND INDEMNIFY which will prevent parents or guardians of my player or my player from recovering damages in any event of injury or death. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT POLICY

The West Salem Lacrosse Club (WSLC) Board has recognized the need to present the following policy in regards to their stance on the Unsportsmanlike Conduct Policy. Following are excerpts from the standard operating procedures and handbooks by which we are governed. Our club's adherence to these rules is the cornerstone for the sport to move to the next level – acceptance as an approved and sanctioned entity under the OSAA. Also, this policy will serve as an agreement between players, parents, coaches, and the board as to the consequences of unsportsmanlike conduct.

Excerpt from Oregon HS Lacrosse Association Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) dated 10/25/14:

23. VIOLATIONS OF REGULATIONS-PENALTIES

- A. Players or coaches who are ejected from games will receive an automatic suspension from the next game per **OSAA Rule 20A - Ejection Policies-Ejected Player or Coach**. Ejected coaches must leave the contest immediately and shall not be allowed further contact with team members for the duration of that contest. An ejected player is required to sit out the remainder of the contest, but may remain on the bench. Should an ejected player participate or an ejected coach remain within "sight and sound" of the team during the period of suspension specified in the Regulations, and no appeal is pending, that action shall be considered use of an ineligible participant and shall result in forfeiture of that contest and other penalties as determined by the Board.
- B. Ejections will result in fines to the team, following the guidelines of **OSAA Rule 21A-Ejection Policies- Fines**. When the first participant or coach is ejected, the team that the participant or coach is representing shall be assessed a \$50 fine by the OHSLA Board. A second ejection in the same season shall result in the assessment of a \$100 fine, and each ejection thereafter within that season shall result in a fine to be increased by \$50 increments for each ejection without limitation.
EXCEPTION: The fine for an ejection in the last contest of the season shall be increased by \$100 over the standard fine for the offense.
- C. Teams receiving a second collective ejection (players or coach) in a season will have to discuss the situation with the Commissioner.
- D. Teams receiving their third collective ejection in a season (player or coach) will face league sanctions, which may include suspension from league play. After a team has received a third ejection within a season, the Head Coach must come before the OHSLA Board to discuss possible solutions to the problem.
- E. Teams in gross or continual violation of league policies may be suspended from OHSLA. OHSLA reserves the right to accept or decline a team's request to re-join the league.
- F. Players or coaches participating in gross misconduct or conduct that is deemed to be detrimental to OHSLA may face further sanctions than simple one game suspensions, even if they have not had an ejection earlier in the season. These penalties will be determined by the OHSLA Board.
- G. All penalties issued by OHSLA are to be considered separate from any penalties that are levied by the school administration.
- H. **EJECTIONS IN TOURNAMENTS AND JAMBOREES**
 1. A coach or player who is ejected in a tournament shall be suspended for the next game at the same level of the game in which he was ejected.
 2. If the game of ejection is an official length game, they will be suspended from the next official length game.
 3. If the game of ejection is a jamboree game, they will miss a full day of jamboree play.
 4. If the coach or player is ejected from the last game of a tournament or jamboree, they will be suspended from the next game on the team's schedule.
